Summer Safety Tips for Your Home & Pets

Using Fireworks:

- Never allow young children to play with or ignite fireworks. Keep pets away.
- Always have an adult supervise fireworks activities.
- Never place any part of your body directly over a fireworks device when lighting the fuse. Back up to a safe distance immediately after lighting fireworks.
- Never try to re-light or pick up fireworks that have not ignited fully.
- Never point or throw fireworks at another person or near houses.
- Keep a bucket of water or a garden hose handy in case of fire or other mishap.
- After fireworks complete their burning, douse the spent device with plenty of water from a bucket or hose before discarding it to prevent a trash fire.

Outdoor Grilling:

- Use propane and charcoal grills outdoors only.
- Place the grill well away from your home, deck railings and out from under eaves and overhanging branches.
- Keep children and pets at least three feet away from the grill area.
- Clean your grill often, removing any grease or fat buildup from the grates and in the trays below.
- Stay next to your grill at all times while cooking; never leave the area unattended

Air Conditioners:

- When using air conditioners, read instructions first.
- Don't use with extension cords.
- Don't overload electrical outlets.
- Unplug when leaving your home.
